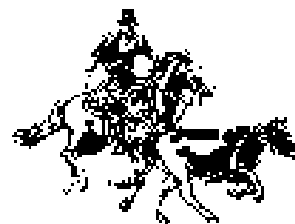

September Cutting Clinic/ Cool Cutters Comp- Practice Day

Saturday is Cutting day and will commence with a Cutting Clinic with Steve Davey, aimed at preparation for the little competition in the afternoon, but open to anyone who is looking at improving their skills in the cutting arena. The cost for the clinic is \$60.00 per person. In the afternoon will be the Cool Cutters two handed competition, plus a possible novice one handed division, referred to as "Open" on the nomination form. Pre-works start at a cost of \$20.00 per run and \$40.00 per run to enter the competition. With Steve Davey judging, the Cool Cutters Competition is aimed at giving members an opportunity to have a go at a small cutting competition or the young horse a bit of an outing under competition conditions. 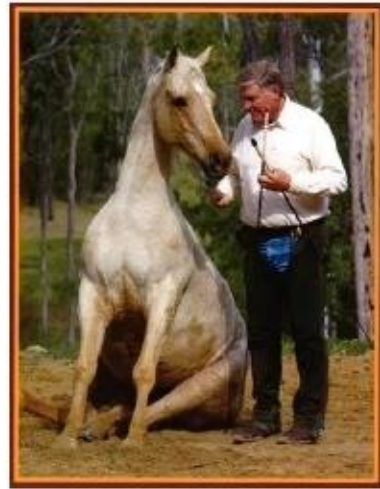

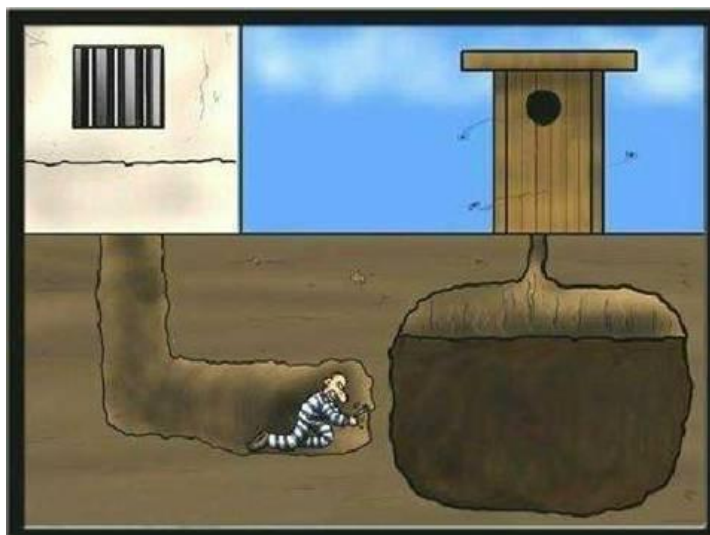

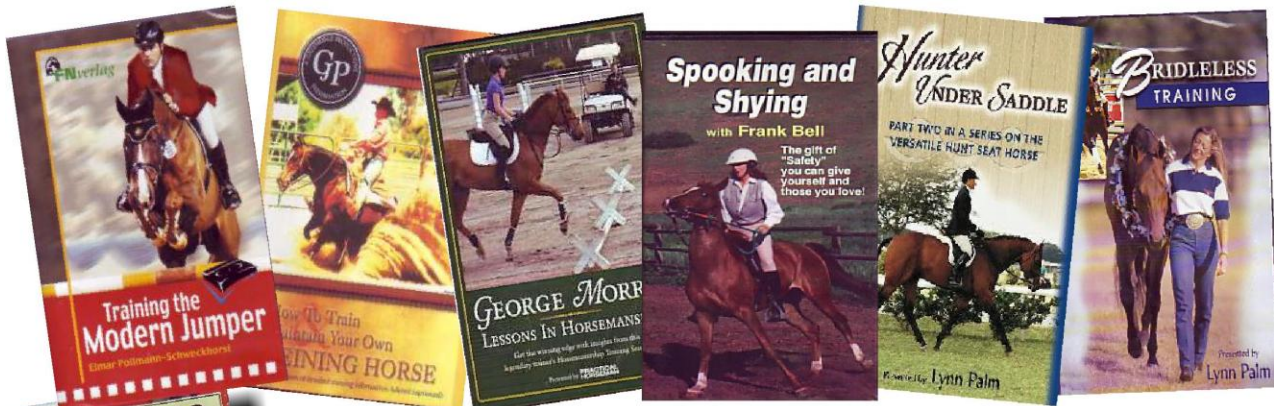
