Rules will be explained. You will be able to nominate on the day and all are encouraged to do so. However, if you could let us know before hand for cattle numbers it would be appreciated. Sound like fun but not sure you if it is for you. There will be help on hand if required and for those not successful in cutting out a beast, one will be released from the camp for you to tackle the course with. So why not give it a go, remember you can go at your own pace with horsemanship playing a big part. No team required, will be an individual event only, Prizes for 1st, 2nd and 3rd in Junior and open events as well as encouragement awards. Multiple entries permitted subject to cattle availability.

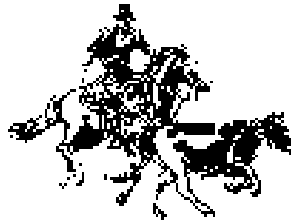
Remember the Dayboro Show is an event put on by the Dayboro Show Society and entry and camping fees are payable to the Show Society.

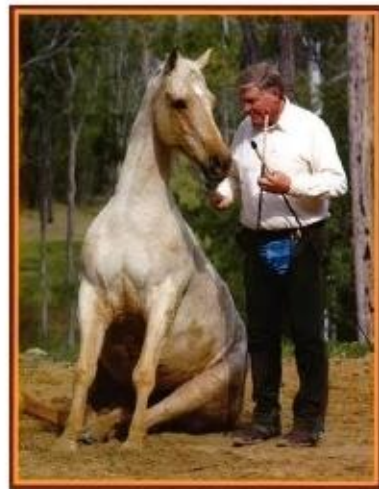
